HOTEL RESERVATIONS:

Hotel reservation must be made directly with the conference hotel or campus housing. The conference hotel, The Chateau Victoria, is a one of the city's best, located in the downtown near the Inner Harbour, dining, shopping, and major tourist attractions. A shuttle bus will help participants move between the hotel and conference site. Campus Housing is located at the University of Victoria near the library and is a short walk from the conference site.
